AN ACT DESIGNATING A CERTAIN TRAFFIC ISLAND ON ROUTE 140 IN THE CITY OF NEW BEDFORD AS THE RAYMOND DEMERS TRAFFIC ISLAND.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The southerly traffic island at the intersection of  
2 Acushnet avenue and Route 140 in the city of New Bedford  
3 shall be known and designated as the Raymond Demers traffic  
4 island, in memory and in honor of Raymond Demers, a warrant  
5 officer in the United States Navy who was killed while serving  
6 upon the aircraft carrier U. S. S. Bennington, and a suitable  
7 tablet or marker bearing said designation shall be erected and  
8 maintained at said island by the state department of public  
9 works.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
