AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE POLICE COMMISSIONER OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 8 of chapter 291 of the acts of 1906, as
2 most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 510 of the acts
3 of 1956, is hereby further amended by striking out, in line 2,
4 the word "fifteen" and inserting in place thereof the word:—
5 twenty,— so that the first paragraph will read as follows:—
6 The annual salary of the police commissioner shall be twenty
7 thousand dollars, and of the secretary an amount which shall be
8 fixed by the police commissioner with the approval of the gov-
9 ernor and council, which shall be paid in monthly instalments
10 by the city of Boston. Subject to the approval of the governor
11 and council, the police commissioner shall be provided with
12 such rooms, which shall be suitably furnished, as shall be con-
13 venient and suitable for the performance of his duties, the ex-
14 pense of which shall be paid by the city of Boston.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance
2 by the city of Boston subject to the provisions of its charter
3 but not otherwise.
