The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Eight.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A REFERENDUM BY COUNTIES IN CONNECTION WITH LICENSING AND CONDUCTING OF A GAME COMMONLY CALLED "BEANO".

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The state secretary shall cause to be placed on the official
2 ballot to be used in the cities and towns at the biennial state
3 election in the year nineteen hundred and fifty-eight, and in
4 every fourth year thereafter, the following question: — "Shall
5 the licensing and conducting of a game commonly called 'Beano'
6 be permitted in this county?" If a majority of the votes cast
7 in a county in answer to said question are in the affirmative,
8 such county shall be taken to have authorized the licensing and
9 conducting of a game commonly called "Beano."
