AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COMPENSATION OF CHIEF PROBATION OFFICERS AND ASSISTANT CHIEF PROBATION OFFICERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The fifth paragraph of section 21 of chapter 276 of the General  
2 Laws, as appearing in section 21 of chapter 731 of the acts of  
3 1956, is hereby amended by adding at the end the following  
4 sentence: — No chief probation officer or assistant chief proba-  
5 tion officer shall receive less compensation than a probation  
6 officer in his respective court.
