### AN ACT RELATIVE TO REGISTRATION FEES FOR CERTAIN TYPES OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Subdivision 7 of section 33 of chapter 90 of the General  
2 Laws, as appearing in chapter 540 of the acts of 1952, is  
3 hereby amended by striking out the sixth, seventh, eighth  
4 and ninth paragraphs and inserting in place thereof the follow-  
5 ing paragraphs:—

6 Less than two hundred and one horse power, as rated by  
7 the manufacturer, fifteen dollars when non-gasoline driven  
8 and four dollars and fifty cents when gasoline driven.

9 Two hundred and one horsepower and above, as rated by  
10 the manufacturer, thirty-seven dollars and fifty cents when  
11 non-gasoline driven and four dollars and fifty cents plus one  
12 dollar for each horsepower in excess of two hundred when  
13 gasoline driven.
