By Mr. Keenan of Boston, petition of the Massachusetts State Employees Association and William Francis Keenan that the Treasurer and Receiver-General be authorized to make advance payments to certain employees during the period their applications for retirement are being processed. AN ACT AUTHORIZING ADVANCE PAYMENTS TO CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH WHO ARE ELIGIBLE FOR RETIREMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The treasurer and receiver-general is hereby authorized to
2 make advance payments in an amount not to exceed any retire-
3 ment allowance actually due to employees of the common-
4 wealth who are eligible for and who have filed application for
5 retirement during such period as is necessary for the processing
6 of such application for retirement. Rules and regulations gov-
7 erning such payment shall be promulgated by the treasurer and
8 receiver-general.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Six

1. The Treasurer and Receiver-General is hereby authorized to
2. make advance payments in amounts not to exceed one-third
3. of the estimated amount due to employees of the common-
4. wealth who are eligible for and who have filed application for
5. the same, and to draw such funds as is necessary for the purpose
6. of such application for payment. Such and necessary pay-
7. ment shall be paid as provided by the Treasurer and
8. Receiver-General.
