AN ACT INCREASING THE MINIMUM RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE OF  
TEACHERS HAVING RETIRED BEFORE NINETEEN HUNDRED AND  
FORTY-NINE BECAUSE OF DISABILITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Any teacher who retired before the year nineteen hundred  
2 and forty-nine because of disability, and who at the time of such  
3 retirement had at least twenty-five years' service, shall, not-  
4 withstanding any provision of law to the contrary, receive a  
5 retirement allowance of not less than fifteen hundred dollars.
