By Mr. Wisniewski of Chicopee, petition of Joseph Wisniewski that the Department of Public Works be authorized to install a traffic signal light at the corner of Exchange Street and West Street in the city of Chicopee. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR A TRAFFIC LIGHT ON CORNER OF EXCHANGE STREET AND WEST STREET, CHICOPEE JUNCTION INTERCEDING ROUTE 5.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works is hereby
2 authorized and directed to provide and install a traffic light
3 or such conveniences as may be necessary and practicable for the
4 approach into Route 5 in the city of Chicopee. This is for the
5 safety and protection of the vehicles and the citizens of Chicopee.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions
2 of this act, the department of public works may expend such
3 sums as are necessary in such installation.
