AN ACT PLACING THE DISTRICT COURTS UNDER THE CONTROL AND JURISDICTION OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any provision of the General Laws or any
- 2 special act or any other law to the contrary, the district courts
- 3 of the commonwealth shall be under the exclusive control, juris-
- 4 diction and maintenance of the commonwealth.
