AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE RETIREMENT OF CHARLES ALPERT FROM THE STATE SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of general or special law to
2 the contrary, and for the purposes of retirement of Charles
3 Alpert, an employee of the commonwealth, under the provisions
4 of section fifty-seven of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws,
5 the employment of the said Charles Alpert as an election warden
6 by the city of Chelsea prior to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred
7 and thirty-nine, shall be construed as meeting the requirements
8 of section sixty of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws.
