By Mr. Cramer of Williamstown, petition of Robert P. Cramer and Silvio O. Conte that the State Tax Commission be authorized to revalue certain land taken by the Department of Natural Resources in the towns of Florida, Savoy and Clarksburg for the purpose of adjusting the amounts to be paid to said towns in lieu of taxes. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE RE-VALUATION OF CERTAIN LAND IN THE TOWNS OF FLORIDA, SAVOY AND CLARKSBURG TAKEN BY THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADJUSTING THE AMOUNTS OF MONEY PAID EACH TOWN BY THE COMMONWEALTH FOR THE LAND TAKEN IN LIEU OF TAXES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to
2 the contrary, and particularly the provisions of section thirteen
3 of chapter fifty-eight of the General Laws, as most recently
4 amended, the state tax commission is hereby authorized and
5 directed to revalue certain land in the towns of Florida, Savoy
6 and Clarksburg taken by the department of natural resources
7 for the purpose of adjusting the amounts of money paid each
8 town by the commonwealth for the land taken in lieu of taxes.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

THE COMPENSATION OF JUDGES

Under the provisions of the act approved March 3, 1909, the following provisions are made:

The chief justice of the United States shall receive an annual salary of \$11,000. The associate justices shall receive an annual salary of \$8,000. The circuit and district judges shall receive an annual salary of \$6,000. The judges of the Supreme Court shall receive an annual salary of \$11,000. The judges of the Court of Appeals shall receive an annual salary of \$8,000. The judges of the District Court shall receive an annual salary of \$6,000.
