AN ACT DESIGNATING A CERTAIN BALL FIELD IN THE TOWN OF NAHANT AS THE BERNARD FRANCIS MEEHAN LITTLE LEAGUE BALL FIELD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized
2 and directed to designate the little league ball field in the rear of
3 the Nahant bathhouse in the town of Nahant as the Bernard
4 Francis Meehan Little League Ball Field. Said metropolitan
5 district commission shall erect on said ball field a suitable marker
6 bearing said designation.
