**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Eight.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE A COST-OF-LIVING INCREASE IN THE SALARIES OF OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Each officer and employee of the commonwealth  
2 holding an office or position subject to the provisions of sections  
3 forty-six to fifty, inclusive, of chapter thirty of the General  
4 Laws shall receive in addition to the salary payable to him in  
5 accordance with the provisions of said sections and the salary  
6 schedule set forth in section forty-six of said chapter thirty an  
7 amount equal to fifteen per cent of said salary.

1 SECTION 2. The wages paid to blind workers by the division  
2 of the blind in the department of education, as provided by  
3 section fourteen of chapter sixty-nine of the General Laws,  
4 shall be increased over the rate paid on June thirtieth, nineteen  
5 hundred and fifty eight by an amount equal to fifteen per cent  
6 thereof.

1 SECTION 3. The salary of each employee in the service of the  
2 commonwealth paid from the treasury thereof, other than an  
3 employee whose salary is specifically fixed by the statute, or an  
4 employee whose salary is increased under the provisions of sec-  
5 tions one and two of this act, shall be increased over the rate  
6 paid June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight, by an  
7 amount equal to fifteen per cent thereof.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect as of July first, nineteen  
2 hundred and fifty-eight.
