AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN NEW FIREPLACES, TABLES, AND OTHER EQUIPMENT, AND TO PROVIDE AMPLE PARKING SPACE FOR CARS AT WALLUM LAKE IN THE TOWN OF DOUGLAS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The department of natural resources is hereby authorized and
- 2 directed to construct and maintain new fireplaces, tables and
- 3 other equipment, and to provide ample parking space for cars
- 4 at Wallum lake in the town of Douglas.
- 5 For the purposes of this act, the department may expend
- 6 such sums as may be appropriated therefor.

The Constitution of Massachusetts

Article I. The Legislature shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 1. The Senate shall be composed of six members, to be chosen by the several towns, counties, cities and towns in the Commonwealth, and of six members to be chosen by the several counties, cities and towns in the Commonwealth.

Section 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of members to be chosen by the several towns, counties, cities and towns in the Commonwealth.
