The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Eight.

AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARIES OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALL COUNTIES EXCEPT SUFFOLK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 5 of chapter 34 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking out the present salary schedule for
3 county commissioners and inserting in place thereof a new and
4 increased salary schedule.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January first, nine-
2 teen hundred and fifty-eight.

The Constitution of the State

Article IV. The Executive and Judicial Departments

Section 1. The executive power shall be vested in the Governor.

Section 2. The Governor shall hold office for four years, and shall be eligible for re-election.

Section 3. The Governor shall have the honor and precedence of a senator, and shall be styled "Governor of the State."

Section 4. The Governor shall have the right to pardon and reprieve.
