The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Eight.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR A CONFERENCE ON EDUCATION.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of education is hereby author-
2 ized and directed to call a conference under its auspices for the
3 purpose of making a study of the needs of education, including
4 higher education in the commonwealth. Said conference shall
5 report to the general court the results of its investigation and
6 study and its recommendations, if any, together with estimates
7 of costs and drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recom-
8 mendations into effect. For the purposes of this resolve, said
9 department may expend such sums as may be appropriated
10 therefor not in excess of ten thousand dollars.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in

Executive Session, on the 10th day of February, 1908,

1. That the department of education is hereby authorized
2. and authorized to call a conference under its auspices for the
3. purpose of making a study of the needs of education, including
4. higher education in the Commonwealth, said conference shall
5. report to the general court the results of its investigation and
6. study and the recommendations it may, together with estimates
7. of cost and details of legislation necessary to carry such recommendations
8. into effect. For the purpose of this section, said
9. department may employ such sum as may be appropriated
10. therefor out of moneys of the Commonwealth.
