AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CHARGING OF FEES BY THE REGISTRY OF MOTOR VEHICLES FOR THE RENEWAL OF OPERATORS' LICENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subdivision 7 of section 33 of chapter 90 of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended in the fourteenth paragraph thereof by
3 adding the following sentence:— Upon the renewal of the
4 license to operate a motor vehicle of any person against whom
5 points have been assessed, the registrar shall, in addition to the
6 fee fixed for such renewal, collect an additional charge of one
7 dollar per point for each point so assessed; such additional
8 charge to be collected for the two such renewals next following
9 the date of the assessment of such points.,— so that said
10 fourteenth paragraph shall read as follows:— For every license
11 to operate motor vehicles or any renewal thereof, five dollars,
12 but no fee shall be collected for the renewal of a license re-
13 stricted to the operation of motor-propelled fire apparatus only.
14 Upon the renewal of the license to operate a motor vehicle of
15 any person against whom points have been assessed, the registrar
16 shall, in addition to the fee fixed for such renewal, collect an
17 additional charge of one dollar per point for each point so
18 assessed; such additional charge to be collected for the two
19 such renewals next following the date of the assessment of such
20 points.
