### AN ACT DESIGNATING THE STATE HIGHWAY NUMBERED ROUTE 140 AS THE "TRAIL OF THE UNKNOWN SOLDIERS."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The state highway numbered Route 140 shall  
2 be known and designated as the "Trail of the Unknown Sol-  
3 diers" in honor of and in tribute to the unknown soldiers of  
4 Massachusetts who gave their lives in action in all wars, and  
5 suitable markers bearing said designation shall be erected along  
6 said highway by the state department of public works.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

THE CONSTITUTION OF CALIFORNIA

ARTICLE I. THE LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENT

SECTION 1. The legislative power of the State shall be vested in the Senate and Assembly.

SECTION 2. The Senate shall be composed of members elected by the electors of the State.

SECTION 3. The Assembly shall be composed of members elected by the electors of the State.

SECTION 4. The members of the Senate shall be elected for terms of two years.

SECTION 5. The members of the Assembly shall be elected for terms of two years.

SECTION 6. The members of the Senate shall be elected in the following manner:
