AN ACT DESIGNATING ROUTE 128 AS THE ELECTRONIC HIGHWAY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE

IN THE SENATE

1. The state government is hereby established as follows:  
2. The executive power shall be vested in the Governor.  
3. The legislative power shall be vested in the Senate and the House of Representatives.  
4. The judicial power shall be vested in the Supreme Court and the inferior courts as may be established by law.  
5. The power of impeachment shall be vested in the Senate.  
6. The power of pardon shall be vested in the Governor.  
7. The power of appointment and removal shall be vested in the Governor.
