By Mr. Howard of Westminster, petition of Richard A. Baker and another (selectmen) that the town of Ashburnham be authorized to borrow money for the purchase, remodeling and equipping of an existing structure and land for use by the various town departments. Municipal Finance.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF ASHBURNHAM TO BORROW MONEY FOR THE PURCHASE, REMODELING AND EQUIPPING OF AN EXISTING STRUCTURE AND LAND FOR USE BY THE VARIOUS TOWN DEPARTMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 For the purpose of purchasing, remodeling and equipping
2 for the use of the various town departments an existing structure
3 and the land on which it is situated, known as Wilson's Garage
4 and located in the town of Ashburnham, said town of Ashburn-
5 ham may borrow, from time to time, within a period of two
6 years from the passage of this act, such sums as may be necessary
7 not exceeding in the aggregate nineteen thousand dollars, and
8 may issue bonds and notes therefor which shall bear on their
9 face the words Town of Ashburnham Public Works Building
10 Loan Act of 1958. Each authorized issue shall constitute a
11 separate loan, and such loans shall be paid in not more than ten
12 years from their dates. Indebtedness incurred under this act
13 shall be in excess of any statutory limit, but shall, except as
14 herein provided, be subject to chapter forty-four of the General
15 Laws; provided, however, that the limitation contained in the
16 first paragraph of section seven of said chapter forty-four shall
17 apply to any loan authorized by the provisions of this act.
