AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF LYNN TO PAY AN ANNUITY TO ABBIE R. GOUDEY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of promoting the public good,
2 and in consideration of the long and efficient service of Bernard
3 E. Goudey as a member of the city of Lynn fire department, the
4 city of Lynn may appropriate and pay to Abbie R. Goudey,
5 widow of the said Bernard E. Goudey, so long as she remains
6 unmarried, an annuity not to exceed fifteen hundred dollars,
7 the same to be paid to her in equal monthly installments.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its acceptance
2 by the city of Lynn by vote of city council and approval of the
3 mayor.
