AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT OF MUNICIPAL LABORERS AND JANITORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The provisions of sections eighty-one A, eighty-one B, eighty-
2 three A and eighty-five E of chapter thirty-two of the General
3 Laws, relative to the non-contributory retirement of police
4 officers and firemen in cities and towns, shall hereafter apply to
5 all laborers and janitors employed by cities and towns in which
6 said sections are operative.
