## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Eight.

AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE JUSTICE OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF NEWTON AND PROVIDING THAT SAID JUSTICE SHALL DEVOTE HIS ENTIRE TIME DURING BUSINESS HOURS TO HIS JUDICIAL DUTIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 77A of chapter 218 of the General  
2 Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 738 of the acts of  
3 1956, is hereby further amended by inserting after the word  
4 "the", in line 2, the words: — district court of Newton.

1 SECTION 2. Section 78 of chapter 218 of the General Laws,  
2 as most recently amended by chapter 738 of the acts of 1956,  
3 is hereby further amended by striking out the first sentence.
