AN ACT PROVIDING FOR STATE REIMBURSEMENT OF THE EXPENSES OF ADMINISTERING OLD AGE ASSISTANCE AND AID TO DEPENDENT CHILDREN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 118 of the General Laws,
2 as most recently amended by chapter 491 of the acts of 1943,
3 is hereby further amended by inserting after the first sentence
4 the following sentence: — In addition the town shall be reim-
5 bursed for one fourth of the expenses of administering this
6 chapter.

1 SECTION 2. Section 8 of chapter 118A of the General Laws,
2 as most recently amended by chapter 462 of the acts of 1953, is
3 hereby further amended by inserting after the first sentence the
4 following sentence: — In addition the town shall be reimbursed
5 for one fourth of the expenses of administering this chapter.
