AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE LAW REGULATING HEALTH, WELFARE AND RETIREMENT FUNDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 6 of chapter 151D of the General Laws, as inserted by
- 2 section 2 of chapter 778 of the acts of 1957, is hereby amended
- 3 by inserting at the end thereof the following sentence:—
- 4 The provisions of this chapter shall not apply to compliance or
- 5 action undertaken with respect to the provisions of chapter one
- 6 hundred and fifty-two of the General Laws, or other workmen's
- 7 compensation laws.
