AN ACT RESTRICTING THE USE OF NATURAL WATERS OF THE TOWN  
OF PEMBROKE BY OTHER CITIES AND TOWNS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Further exploitation of the natural water sources  
2 of the town of Pembroke shall be prohibited by cities or towns  
3 other than the said town of Pembroke.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
