## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Eight.

### AN ACT REQUIRING CERTAIN RECORDS TO BE KEPT BY PERSONS WHO TAKE X-RAY PICTURES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-  
2 serting after section 2C, inserted by section 1 of chapter 655 of  
3 the acts of 1957, the following section: —

4 *Section 2D.* Whoever shall take an X-ray picture of a human  
5 being shall keep a written record of the date the picture was  
6 taken, the name, address, date of birth, sex and weight of the  
7 subject, the number of exposures taken, the purpose of the  
8 examination, the name and address of the X-ray operator and  
9 the name and address of the person ordering the X-ray, if other  
10 than the subject. Any part of the aforesaid information shall  
11 be furnished to the subject, his administrator or executor, to a  
12 parent or guardian if the subject is a minor, or to any person  
13 designated by the subject. Whoever violates any provision of  
14 this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than one  
15 hundred dollars.
