AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A FIVE PER CENT WAGE DIFFERENTIAL FOR EMPLOYEES OF HOSPITALS OPERATED BY THE COMMONWEALTH FOR THE TREATMENT OF CONTAGIOUS DISEASES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 30 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
2 serting after subsection (11) of section 46, as inserted by sec-
3 tion 13 of chapter 729 of the acts of 1956, the following sub-
4 section:—

5 (12) Notwithstanding any provision of this section to the
6 contrary, all employees of hospitals operated by the common-
7 wealth devoted to the treatment of contagious diseases, or em-
8 ployed in wards or divisions devoted to the treatment of con-
9 tagious diseases, shall receive, in addition to the wages received
10 by others in the same job group but not so employed, five per
11 cent additional wages.
