AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION OF ONE THOUSAND FEET OF SEAWALL ALONG WATER STREET IN THE CITY OF NEWBURYPORT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The division of waterways in the department of
2 public works is hereby authorized and directed to undertake the
3 reconstruction of one thousand feet of seawall along Water
4 street in the city of Newburyport.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage
