AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF A BUILDING IN THE VILLAGE OF WHITINSVILLE IN THE TOWN OF NORTHBRIDGE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO BE USED AS A SUBSIDIARY REGISTRY OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public works is hereby authorized and
2 directed to maintain, in the village of Whitinsville and town
3 of Northbridge, a building to be used for the purposes of a
4 registry of motor vehicles to all extents and purposes for which
5 the present registry of motor vehicles is used. For said pur-
6 poses, such department may expend such sums as may be
7 appropriated therefor.

The Commission of Enquiry

into the Affairs of the Government of India

The Commission was constituted on the 1st of August 1904, and its terms of reference were defined by the following resolution of the Council of the Government of India:

The Commission is to inquire into the following matters:

1. The administration of the Government of India.
2. The relations between the Government of India and the various departments of the Government of the Provinces.
3. The financial administration of the Government of India.
4. The public service of the Government of India.
5. The public service of the Government of the Provinces.
6. The public service of the Government of the States.
7. Any other matters which may be referred to the Commission.
