By Mr. Chadwick of Winchester, petition of Harry L. Wood, Jr., that the Metropolitan District Commission be authorized to drain the outlet for Cranberry Pond in the town of Winchester. Metropolitan Affairs.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO PROVIDE DRAINAGE OF THE OUTLET FOR CRANBERRY POND, IN THE TOWN OF WINCHESTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized
2 and directed to perform such construction work as will ul-
3 mately properly drain the outlet of Cranberry pond, also known
4 as Long pond, in the town of Winchester, to prevent over-
5 flowing. For said purpose, said commission may expend such
6 sums as may be appropriated therefor.

The Constitution of Massachusetts

As amended by the People and House of Representatives in 1990

ARTICLE I. OF THE RIGHTS OF THE SUBJECTS OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Section 1. The legislative power shall be vested in a Senate and House of Representatives, chosen by the People, and by the authority of the Senate, as follows:

1. The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized
2. and directed to perform such construction work as will aff-
3. ordably provide light and water to the city of Cambridge, and to
4. in doing so, in the town of Cambridge, to provide water
5. for said purpose, and to make any other such
6. use as may be appropriate therefor.
