AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ACQUISITION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS OF FORT PHOENIX AND FORT PHOENIX BEACH IN FAIRHAVEN, AND ITS DEVELOPMENT BY THE DIVISION OF PUBLIC BEACHES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public works is hereby authorized and
2 directed to acquire by gift or purchase, or take by eminent
3 domain under chapter seventy-nine of the General Laws, certain
4 land in the town of Fairhaven known as Fort Phoenix and land
5 known as Fort Phoenix beach which includes the beach front of
6 about twenty-two hundred feet and the buildings thereon.
7 Upon the acquisition of same the division of public beaches in
8 said department shall assume the control, development and
9 supervision thereof. For the purposes of this act there may be
10 expended such sums, not exceeding two hundred and fifty thou-
11 sand dollars, as may be appropriated therefor.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION OF THE BUSINESS OF
INSURANCE AND TO AMEND AN ACT PASSED IN THE YEAR ONE
THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN, RELATIVE TO THE
REGULATION OF THE BUSINESS OF INSURANCE.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. The Department of Public Safety is hereby authorized and
empowered to receive for any or sundry of the purposes herein
expressed, any and every application for a license to transact
the business of insurance in this Commonwealth, and to issue
such license, subject to such conditions as it may see fit to impose,
and to revoke or suspend such license, and to require the holder
thereof to furnish such security as it may see fit to require, and
to require the holder thereof to file with it such reports and
statements as it may see fit to require, and to do all such other
things as it may see fit to do, in relation to the business of
insurance, and to enforce the provisions of this act, and to
make such rules and regulations as it may see fit to make, in
relation to the business of insurance, and to do all such other
