RESOLVE VALIDATING THE ACTS OF JEAN B. ROBILLARD AS A
NOTARY PUBLIC.

1 *Resolved*, That the acts of Jean B. Robillard of Springfield
2 as a notary public between January fifth, nineteen hundred and
3 fifty-two and December twenty-seventh, nineteen hundred and
4 fifty-seven, both dates inclusive, in so far as the same may have
5 been invalid by reason of the fact that, upon the change of her
6 name from Jean B. Bradish, she failed to re-register under her
7 new name and pay to the state secretary a fee of one dollar as
8 required by section thirteen of chapter thirty of the General
9 Laws, are hereby confirmed and made valid.
