Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1 of chapter 124 of the acts of 1952 is hereby amended
- 2 by striking out, in line 2, the word "three" and inserting in place
- 3 thereof the word: five, so as to read as follows: Sec-
- 4 tion 1. The town of Bourne may annually appropriate a sum,
- 5 not exceeding five thousand dollars, for the purpose of adver-
- 6 tising the advantages of the town, with special reference to its
- 7 facilities for summer vacation, recreation, seashore, residential
- 8 and small manufacturing purposes. The money so appropriated
- 9 shall be expended under the direction of the selectmen.
