AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY WHICH THE TOWN OF
BOURNE MAY EXPEND FOR ADVERTISING PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 124 of the acts of 1952 is hereby amended
2 by striking out, in line 2, the word "three" and inserting in place
3 thereof the word:— five, — so as to read as follows:— *Sec-*
4 *tion 1.* The town of Bourne may annually appropriate a sum,
5 not exceeding five thousand dollars, for the purpose of adver-
6 tising the advantages of the town, with special reference to its
7 facilities for summer vacation, recreation, seashore, residential
8 and small manufacturing purposes. The money so appropriated
9 shall be expended under the direction of the selectmen.
