### AN ACT RELATIVE TO SICK LEAVE FOR STATE EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law
- 2 to the contrary, the commission on administration and finance
- 3 is hereby authorized to extend sick leave allowances of any state
- 4 employee under such circumstances and for such periods of time
- 5 as in its discretion shall be considered desirable.
