RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO THE CONTINUATION OF THE TRANSPORTATION SERVICE IN THE AREAS SERVED BY THE NEW YORK, NEW HAVEN AND HARTFORD RAILROAD COMPANY.

1 *Resolved*, That the unpaid special commission, established by
2 chapter one hundred and fifty-two of the resolves of nineteen
3 hundred and fifty-six, and most recently revived and continued
4 by chapter forty-three of the resolves of the current year, to
5 make an investigation and study relative to the continuation of
6 the transportation service in the areas served by the New York,
7 New Haven and Hartford Railroad Company, shall, in the course
8 of its investigation and study, consider the subject matter of
9 current senate document numbered 530, relative to the exemp-
10 tion from local taxation of the real estate owned by the Boston
11 Terminal Corporation; of current senate document numbered
12 531, relative to the Boston Terminal Corporation, the assess-
13 ment of its real estate and the payment of taxes thereon; and
14 of current house document numbered 2159, relative to repealing
15 provisions of law relative to the Boston Terminal Company.
