AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, DIVISION OF WATERWAYS, TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN STONE GROINS OR JETTIES ALONG THE SHORE OF PLUM ISLAND WITHIN THE CITY OF NEWBURYPORT AND THE TOWN OF NEWBURY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works, division of  
2 waterways, is hereby authorized and directed to construct and  
3 maintain four stone groins or jetties along the shore of Plum  
4 island within the city of Newburyport and the town of Newbury.  
5 Said department shall utilize all prior studies and surveys made  
6 of the storm damage and erosion along with current studies and  
7 surveys, and shall expend for the purposes of this act such sums  
8 as may be appropriated therefor, but shall not exceed a total  
9 cost of one hundred and fifty thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
