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*Ordered,* That the unpaid special committee established by an order adopted by the Senate on May 22, 1957, and by the House on May 27, 1957, and continued by an order adopted by the Senate and House on January 22, 1958, to investigate and study the proposed increase in premiums contemplated by Massachusetts Hospital Service, Inc., and Massachusetts Medical Service, Inc., operators and owners of the hospital and medical plans known as "Blue Cross" and "Blue Shield", and also of the management, control, fiscal policies, and methods of operation of said "Blue Cross" "Blue Shield", shall, in the course of its investigation and study, consider the subject matter of current senate document numbered 686, relative to maternity benefits under accident and sickness insurance policies, non-profit hospital service plans and contracts and medical service contracts.
