RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO FURTHER DEFINING THE WORD "EMPLOYEE" AS USED IN THE CONTRIBUTORY GROUP GENERAL OR BLANKET INSURANCE LAW FOR PERSONS IN THE SERVICE OF A COUNTY, CITY, TOWN OR DISTRICT AND THEIR DEPENDENTS.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission to consist of two  
2 members of the senate to be designated by the president thereof,  
3 three members of the house of representatives to be designated  
4 by the speaker thereof, and two persons to be appointed by the  
5 governor, is hereby established for the purpose of making an  
6 investigation and study of the subject matter of current senate  
7 document numbered 722, relative to further defining the word  
8 "employee" as used in the contributory group general or blanket  
9 insurance law for persons in the service of a county, city, town  
10 or district and their dependents. Said commission shall be pro-  
11 vided with quarters in the state house or elsewhere, may hold  
12 hearings, may travel within the commonwealth, and may ex-  
13 pend for legal, clerical and other services and expenses such  
14 sums as may hereafter be appropriated therefor. Said commis-  
15 sion shall report to the general court the results of its investiga-  
16 tion and study and its recommendations, if any, together with  
17 drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recommendations  
18 into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of  
19 representatives on or before the last Tuesday of December in  
20 the current year.
