RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR THE CONTINUANCE OF AN INVESTIGATION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH RELATIVE TO THE SANITARY CONDITION OF THE ABERJONA RIVER AND THE MYSTIC LAKES IN THE CITIES OF MEDFORD AND WOBURN AND THE TOWNS OF ARLINGTON, BURLINGTON, READING, STONEHAM, WINCHESTER AND WILMINGTON.

1     *Resolved*, That the department of public health is hereby au-  
2     thorized and directed to further continue its investigation of  
3     the sanitary condition of the Aberjona river, the Mystic lakes  
4     and their tributaries in the cities of Medford and Woburn and  
5     the towns of Arlington, Burlington, Reading, Stoneham, Win-  
6     chester and Wilmington. The department shall investigate the  
7     capacities of the metropolitan district commission and municipal  
8     sewers and their ability to serve adequately the area drained  
9     by the Aberjona river. It shall report to the general court its  
10    findings, and its recommendations, if any, for preventing the  
11    future pollution of the Aberjona river, the Mystic lakes and  
12    their tributaries, and providing an outlet for the sewage and in-  
13    dustrial wastes of the area, together with drafts of legislation  
14    necessary to carry said recommendations into effect, by filing  
15    the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or  
16    before the last Tuesday of December in the current year. For  
17    the purposes of this resolve, said department may expend the  
18    unexpended balance in item 2002-28 of section two of chapter  
19    seven hundred and forty-three of the acts of nineteen hundred  
20    and fifty-seven, and such sums as may be appropriated therefor.
