AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT OF DEATH BENEFITS TO MEMBERS OF THE FITCHBURG FIREMENS RELIEF ASSOCIATION UPON THEIR RETIREMENT FROM THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF FITCHBURG.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Any member of the Fitchburg Firemens Relief
2 Association who ceases to be a member of the Fitchburg fire
3 department shall thereupon cease to be a member of said as-
4 sociation, and shall no longer be entitled to any benefits there-
5 from; provided, however, that any member of said association
6 who ceases to be a member of the Fitchburg fire department by
7 reason of being retired shall, within thirty days after such retire-
8 ment, be paid from the funds of said association a sum of money
9 equal to the death benefit provided by its by-laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January first, nine-
2 teen hundred and fifty-nine.
