Silva and others that the board of park commissioners of the city of New Bedford be authorized to transfer a part of Buttonwood Park to the board of trustees of the free public library of said city. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF A CERTAIN PARCEL OF BUTTUNWOOD PARK IN THE CITY OF NEW BEDFORD FROM THE BOARD OF PARK COMMISSIONERS TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE FREE PUBLIC LIBRARY OF SAID CITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The board of park commissioners of the city of
2 New Bedford is hereby authorized to transfer, free from all
3 restrictions, to the board of trustees of the free public library of
4 said city, a certain parcel of land in said city acquired for park
5 or other recreational purposes, and bounded and described as
6 follows:—

7 Beginning at the point of intersection of the westerly line of
8 Rockdale avenue with the southerly line of Lake street; thence
9 westerly in said southerly line of Lake street a distance of two
10 hundred twenty-five (225) feet to a point; thence southerly in
11 a line, parallel to and two hundred twenty-five (225) feet from
12 the westerly line of Rockdale avenue a distance of two hundred
13 twenty-five (225) feet to a point; thence easterly in a line,
14 parallel to and two hundred twenty-five (225) feet from the
15 southerly line of Lake street, a distance of two hundred twenty-
16 five (225) feet to a point in the westerly line of Rockdale avenue;
17 thence northerly in said westerly line of Rockdale avenue a dis-

18 tance of two hundred twenty-five (225) feet to the point of
19 beginning; containing 50,625 square feet, being a portion of
20 Buttonwood park in said city.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by
2 the city council of the city of New Bedford in accordance with
3 the terms of its charter, but not otherwise.
