AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF HAMPSHIRE TO HAVE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS PREPARED FOR REPAIRS, ALTERATIONS AND AN ADDITION TO THE COURT HOUSE OF SAID COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The county commissioners of the county of
2 Hampshire are hereby authorized and directed to have plans
3 and specifications prepared for repairs, alterations and an ad-
4 dition to the court house of said county. For said purposes,
5 said commissioners may expend such sums, not exceeding twenty-
6 five thousand dollars, as may be provided therefor in the ap-
7 propriations for the current year for said county.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
