AN ACT TO EXTEND THE AVAILABILITY OF AN EXISTING APPROPRIATION FOR THE COMPENSATION OF THE MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 434 of the Acts of 1958 is hereby amended
2 by striking out, in line 2, Item 2301-01 of section 2, the word
3 "five" and inserting in place thereof the word: — seven, — so as
4 to read as follows: — "2301-01 for personal services of the
5 commissioners, including not more than seven permanent
6 positions."

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
