AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF REGISTRATION OF HAIRDRESSERS TO GRANT A PERMIT FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ACADEMY FOR INSTRUCTION IN ADVANCED METHODS OF HAIR DESIGNING.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-  
2 serting after section 87KK the following section:—  
3 *Section 87LL.* The board may grant to any registered hair-  
4 dresser or group of hairdressers a permit to establish and main-  
5 tain under its supervision an academy for instruction of regis-  
6 tered hairdressers in advanced methods of hair designing. There  
7 may be employed in said academy, from within or without the  
8 commonwealth, qualified demonstrators, instructors, lecturers  
9 and stylists who shall not be required to obtain a license for the  
10 purpose of acting as such. A person employed as an instructor  
11 in said academy may operate his own place of business, notwith-  
12 standing any provision of law to the contrary.
