AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME WITHIN WHICH CERTAIN SOLDIERS AND SAILORS AND THEIR WIVES, WIDOWS, FATHERS OR MOTHERS MAY FILE APPLICATION FOR ABATEMENT OR EXEMPTION OF TAXES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 534 of the acts of 1949 is hereby amended by striking
2 out section 3, as most recently amended by chapter 41 of the
3 acts of 1957, and inserting in place thereof the following sec-
4 tion:—

5 *Section 3.* Application for abatement or exemption, as pro-
6 vided in sections one and two, of taxes levied in the year nineteen
7 hundred and fifty-seven may be made not later than October
8 first, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight, notwithstanding any
9 provision of law to the contrary.
