AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT RIGHTS OF ANTHONY A. BONZAGNI.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the
2 contrary, the retirement allowance of Anthony A. Bonzagni of
3 Winthrop, a member of the state retirement system, who was
4 retired on January first, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven, as
5 deputy registrar of motor vehicles, after nearly forty-three years
6 of service in the division of motor vehicles, shall be recomputed
7 and paid as though the provisions of section five of chapter
8 thirty-two of the General Laws, as amended by section one of
9 chapter six hundred and sixty-one of the acts of nineteen hun-
10 dred and fifty-seven, were in effect at the time of retirement of
11 said Anthony A. Bonzagni.

1 SECTION 2. Section one of this act shall be deemed to have
2 been in force on and since January first, nineteen hundred and
3 fifty-seven, and the monthly retirement allowance payments
4 payable to said Anthony A. Bonzagni on and since said date
5 shall be recomputed and paid in accordance with the provisions
6 of said section one.
