Chap. 219. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF EASTHAMPTON TO CONVEY A CERTAIN PARCEL OF PARK LAND TO CLARENCE E. LAMOUREUX.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The town of Easthampton is hereby authorized to sell and convey to Clarence E. Lamoureux a certain parcel of park land in said town, located at the corner of Glendale street and Knight avenue, and bounded and described as follows: —

Beginning at the junction of Glendale Street and Knight Avenue, so called, and running in a southeasterly direction along said Knight Avenue a distance of one hundred and thirty-six and eighty-five hundredths (136.85) feet to Lot No. 18 on a Plan of Lots recorded in Hampshire County Registry of Deeds in Book 663, Pages 370 and 371; thence running in a northeasterly direction along said Lot No. 18 a distance of one hundred and thirty-nine and ten hundredths (139.10) feet to Glendale Street aforesaid; thence running in a westerly direction along said Glendale Street a distance of one hundred and ninety-five and thirteen hundredths (195.13) feet to the point of beginning; said tract being triangular in shape and containing nine thousand five hundred and eighteen (9518) square feet and designated as Lot No. 17 on said plan.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by a majority vote of the town meeting members of the town of Easthampton at a regular or special town meeting called for the purpose.

Chap. 220. AN ACT PROVIDING THAT A CERTAIN BRIDGE ON THE PILGRIMS HIGHWAY IN THE TOWN OF ROCKLAND SHALL, WHEN CONSTRUCTED, BE DESIGNATED AS THE DOCTOR JOSEPH H. DUNN BRIDGE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter six hundred and fifty-four of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty, the bridge on the Pilgrims Highway over Hingham street in the town of Rockland shall, when constructed, be known and designated as the Doctor Joseph H. Dunn Bridge, and a suitable marker bearing said designation shall be attached thereto by the department of public works. *Approved March 13, 1961.*

Chap. 221. AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE METROPOLITAN WATER DISTRICT GIVE NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS ON PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS OR EXTENSIONS TO ITS WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM TO CERTAIN OFFICIALS OF MEMBER CITIES AND TOWNS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 26 of chapter 92 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the fourth and fifth paragraphs, as appearing in chapter 618 of the acts of 1953, and inserting in place thereof the following two paragraphs: —
