**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Eight.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF CLASSIFICATIONS UNDER THE COMPULSORY MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY INSURANCE LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 113B of chapter 175 of the General  
2 Laws, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the  
3 end the following paragraphs:—

4 The commissioner in his classification of risks and determina-  
5 tion of premium charges shall place in the schedule of premium  
6 charges under class one any person under the age of twenty-five  
7 years who for a period of three full years has not been involved  
8 in an accident in which he has been determined to be at fault,  
9 and that the parent of any person in whose household there is  
10 such an operator under the age of twenty-five years shall be  
11 included in this classification.

12 The question of responsibility relating to an accident in  
13 which a person under the age of twenty-five years is involved  
14 shall be determined by the registrar of motor vehicles in accord-  
15 ance with the provisions of chapter ninety A.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January first,  
2 nineteen hundred and fifty-nine.
